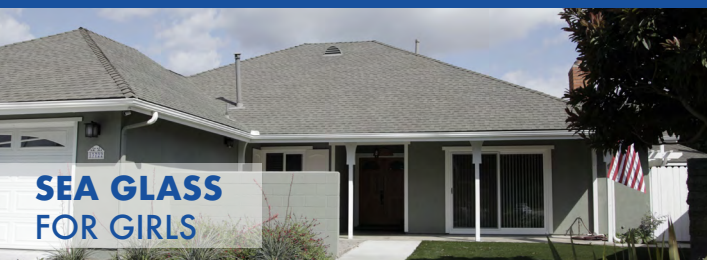

## PROVIDING A HOME FOR TEENS IN CRISIS SINCE 1985

Hope Harbor exists to help families with teens in crisis by providing a safe and nurturing home for teens to work towards restoration and family reunification. By keeping teens off the streets, we keep them safe from human trafficking, gang involvement, and a life of drug and alcohol dependency.

Nestled in beautiful, residential neighborhoods, Hope Harbor has two homes that each provide housing for up to six teens for 12-18 months, live-in House Parents, individual and family counseling, academic support, life skills training, and all basic necessities.



## INTAKE PROCESS

The House Parents will conduct interviews with the teen and parents to determine eligibility. We are licensed as a Group Home with the State of California. We will never turn anyone away based on finances. Call (714) 832-0207 for more information or to initiate the process.

# WHY HOPE HARBOR WORKS

Hope Harbor is a unique, preventative care program that provides more than temporary relief to teens in crisis:

- Live-in House Parents, rather than a shift rotation of staff
- 12-18 months of safe shelter
- Individual and family counseling
- Life-skills training
- Transportation to school and academic support
- Nurturing home environment
- Faith-based program
- Two homes, each with a six-bed capacity



## IS HOPE HARBOR RIGHT FOR YOU AND YOUR TEEN?

### ELIGIBILITY

**Hope Harbor serves at-risk teens who:**

- Are willing, with their parents/legal guardians, to work towards family reunification
- Are 12-17 years old
- May have one or more of the following:
  - A history of running away or homelessness
  - Behavioral and/or educational struggles
  - Experimented with drugs or alcohol
  - Signs of depression and/or erratic behavior
  - Need a temporary break from their families due to tense circumstances at home

**Unfortunately, teens are not eligible if they:**

- Are emancipated minors
- Are in need of medical detoxification
- Present a clear danger to themselves or others
- Are pregnant
